Rotarian Paul Dean introduced Jesse Brown of the GBI Division of Forensic Science (crime lab). Brown, a Georgia Southern graduate, joined Forensic Science in 2001, starting out as a forensic chemist for explosives. In December 2001 he joined the Clandestine Laboratory Response Team. He analyzes evidence for the presence of controlled substances. He provided information about the increased use of methamphetamines, a stimulant that is the cheapest drug to make. Methamphetamine usage rose in Georgia beginning in 1995. In December of 2000, the GBI decided to make a concentrated effort to close down meth labs. In three years the number of meth cases has increased from 30 to 300. Another change in crime lab work includes testifying in court where previously his work concluded with the analysis report.

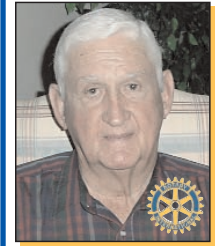

MEMBER PROFILE

Jack Carlton

Rotarian Jack Carlton has been an active Rotarian since the early 1960's. Previous clubs where he has been a member include New Orleans, Murfreesboro (TN), and Macon. He joined the Milledgeville club in 1996. He and his wife, Mary, came to the area in 1982 and began building (by themselves) their retirement home. It was finished in 1987 and they moved in. In 1990, Jack was still vice president for academic affairs at Clayton State, so lived part-time in Jonesboro area. He spent his career in higher education having served as chancellor of Western Carolina University and president of Macon "Junior College" when it opened. He is impressed with the level of activity and organization in our club; none of his previous clubs were as involved. As he noted, larger clubs usually aren't as involved in the community as the Milledgeville club is. He is also pleased with the apparent willingness of the female members to become actively involved with the work of the club.
