**Boosting Rotary club membership
 with great PR**

Throughout the 2004-05 centennial year, Rotary clubs worldwide pulled out the stops to publicize Rotary in local newspapers, magazines, TV broadcasts, and other media outlets. One clear measurement highlights the campaign's success: an increased interest in membership.

Following heightened media coverage during 2004-05, the number of prospective member forms submitted worldwide increased by 13 percent, compared with 2003-04. Non-Rotarians complete these forms, available at www.rotary.org, to express interest in joining a club.

Many clubs and districts that launched previous public image campaigns can attest to the benefits of publicity:

- In January 2003, an interview with past RI President Luis V. Gay about Rotary's educational programs aired on "CNN En Español." Over the next month, there was a 683 percent increase in prospective member forms submitted from Bolivia, Colombia, Mexico, Nicaragua, and Venezuela. Nearly all of the prospective members reported that they had seen the television program about Rotary.

- In July 2004, the London Times published an article and a letter to the editor about the changing membership and activities of Rotary clubs in the United Kingdom. BBC Radio also aired a segment about local clubs. Nearly three times more prospective member forms were submitted from the UK during this period of heightened publicity than during a typical month.
