Rotary License Plate Update

The law authorizing Georgia's Rotary International Prestige License Plate (Official Code of Georgia, Annotated, Section 40-2-86.9) was signed by Governor Sonny Perdue on May 20, 2004. Out of 39 bills introduced into the 2004 Georgia General Assembly to create a prestige license plate - only Rotary International's effort became a reality.

The law provides that 1,000 license plate applications must first be received by the State between July 1, 2004 and June 30, 2006 before any license plates will be manufactured and distributed by the State. (In the past, only 500 tag orders use to be required to trigger manufacture and distribution of specialty license plates, but that number was increased to 1,000.)

As of March 20, 2006, 544 applications have been received by the State; thus 456 more applications are required before we will see any Rotary International license plates on the roadways and highways of Georgia. If we do not reach 1,000 total applications by June 30, 2006, the application fees already received by and being held by the State will be refunded in their entirety to each applicant and the Rotary International Prestige License Plate will be relegated to just another good idea that never fully materialized.

A Georgia Rotary International Prestige License Plate can be ordered in one of the following three ways:

- (1) an individual applicant must:
 - (a) Go to their local County Tag Agent's Office (Tax Commissioner);
 - (b) Show proof of name and residency (use Driver's License);
 - (c) Pay \$25.00 - made payable to their local County Tag Agent; and
 - (d) Hold onto the receipt until their license plate arrives.

OR

(2) If an applicant wants to mail their "application" in, they can print out the attachment and mail it, along with a check for \$25.00, to their local County Tag Agent. In their short note, they should indicate they are making an application for the Georgia Rotary International Prestige License Plate. The County Tag Agent will mail a receipt back to the applicant which the applicant needs to hold onto until receipt of the license plate.

OR

(3) The Rotary Club can designate a point of contact who can print out the attached application and complete the requested information with \$25.00 checks made payable to their local County Tag Agent and hand deliver them to the Tag Office for processing. The receipts will either be mailed to the applicant's home address or given back to the Rotary Club's point of contact for delivery back to the applicant.

Once 1,000 paid applications have been received, they will manufacture and distribute the license plates to all applicants within about sixty (60) days.
