**Order your RI tag now !!**

- The Department of Motor Vehicle Safety (DMVS) must receive a minimum of 1,000 applications before the license plates will begin to be manufactured.
- Applicants must apply for the RI license plate at their local Tax Commissioner's office with payment of a \$25 manufacturing fee.
- A separate application must be completed for every vehicle that will be registered with a RI license plate.
- There are no special qualifications for the issuance of a RI license plate. An applicant may request this plate at any time.
- DMVS will begin to manufacture RI license plates when the required 1,000 applications are received, but not before January 1, 2005.
- The renewal fee will require a \$25 annual special tag fee, along with the \$20 revalidation decal and any ad valorem taxes that may be due.
- The RI license plate is only to promote Rotary International. All manufacturing fees and annual special tag fees are deposited in the State treasury.
