President-Elect Robbie Hattaway was honored by District Governor John Parkins as one of 14 charter members of the District 6920 Paul Harris Society, whose members pledge to contribute \$1000 per year to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund.

District Governor John Parkins presented the "Presidential Citation" and the "Governor's Excellence Award" to the Milledgeville Rotary Club. President Fred Van Horn accepted the awards for the club. Rotary International annually awards the Presidential Citation to clubs that achieve excellence in club service, community service, international service, and vocational service.

The "Governor's Excellence Award" is presented annually to clubs that earn the "Presidential Citation", achieve Rotary International Rotary Foundation annual giving objectives, and achieve District membership objectives. Milledgeville Rotary was one of only 14 of 62 District 6920 clubs to earn the "Governor's Excellence Award".
