Program: Greenway Authority

Fred Williams and William Thompson of the Oconee River Greenway Authority presented a program on the current project to create a greenway and river walk in Milledgeville.

The Greenway Authority is two years old and Thompson serves as chairman of the authority's Foundation. Williams is vice chair. The creation of a greenway and river walk is the focus of the \$4.5 million project. IN addition, it would include historic preservation of old power plant, mills, Indian fish traps and the McMillan Brickyard. The majority of funding for the project is through grants. Applications are current submitted to, among others, the Woodruff Foundation, Georgia Power, One Georgia, and various federal appropriation agencies. Features of the completed project will include an amphitheatre/picnic area, walking and biking trial, restrooms and a boat ramp. Thompson said they hope to let contracts at the end of the year.
