**Time is Running Out to Order  
Your Rotary License Plate!**

The law authorizing Georgia's Rotary International Prestige License Plate provides that 1,000 license plate applications **must first be received by the State between July 1, 2004 and June 30, 2006** before any license plates will be manufactured and distributed by the State.

**To order:**

- (a) Go to the County Tag Agent's Office (Tax Commissioner);
- (b) Show proof of name and residency (use Driver's License);
- (c) Pay \$25.00 - made payable to the County Tag Agent; and
- (d) Hold onto the receipt until your license plate arrives.

**RYLA Around the Corner**

One of the goals of Rotary is to help young people develop their leadership abilities and self-confidence to the fullest. To accomplish that goal, Rotary clubs prepare thousands of young leaders through Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) programs each year.

RYLA brings together individuals from different cultures, educational levels, and work experience with noted community professionals to interact, learn, and discuss strategies for dealing with future challenges and opportunities. In order to qualify, student must:

- Be a high school Junior or Senior
- Hold a position of leadership or be interested in expanding and displaying leadership qualities.
- Be a relative of a Rotarian, foreign exchange student, or past recipient.

RYLA participants attend an all expense paid four day long event on the South Georgia College campus, where individuals can expand their perceptions, learn about themselves, discuss leadership skills, and put those skills to practice. RYLA is a once in a lifetime experience, including stimulating seminars and lectures by top professionals in various fields. Past speakers include: Secretary of Labor Michael Thurmond, Carl Swearinger of BellSouth, Dave Weber of Weber Associates, and many, many more.
