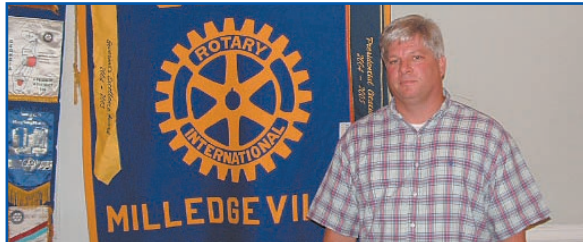

**Meet District Governor Dallas C. Simon, Jr.**

Dallas C. Simon, Jr. was born in Augusta, Georgia. He went to work for Georgia Railroad Bank and Trust Company after graduating from the Academy of Richmond County. This was his first introduction to printing. In 1964 he went to work for the Babcock and Wilcox Company where he created their in-house printing department. At the same time Dallas was starting his first business, as well as working two other part-time jobs. At the age of 22 he created Simon Printing Company. He has since started three other successful businesses, all of which are being operated by his children. He is active in the Georgia Automobile Dealers Association and the Printing Industry of the Carolinas group. He is a past director and officer of the Augusta Jaycees and Sertoma of Augusta. Dallas is active in his community and church He is a past director of the Rachel Longstreet Foundation and a Past Elder in his Church.

Dallas became a Rotarian in 1970 and left Rotary in 1982 to attend to his business. He rejoined Rotary in 1995, and pledged to be "the best Rotarian that he could." He has served on the board and was recognized as "Rotarian of the Year" in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. He also received numerous "Service Above Self" awards from Augusta West, and has nine years of perfect attendance. He is a president of Augusta West, 2001-02 and led his club to overall "Club of the Year." Dallas has served as an Assistant Governor and District Foundation Chairman. He is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow, a Paul Harris sustain member, a Benefactor, and a Will Watt Fellow.

Dallas and his wife Pat, also a Paul Harris fellow, have four children and two grandchildren. His Daughter Kelli Harberson is a Rotarian an a Paul Harris Fellow.
