Rotary receives Special Recognition Award from the American Academy of Ophthalmologists for its efforts to prevent blindness

The American Academy of Ophthalmology (AAO) recognized Rotary International for its many efforts to prevent blindness worldwide during the AAO Annual Meeting in Chicago on Oct. 14-16.

Representing Rotary was Frank J. Devlyn, chair of The Rotary Foundation Trustees, who accepted the academy's 2005 Special Recognition Award honoring Rotary for giving "special emphasis to avoidable blindness, including initiating hundreds of eye care projects around the world."

Rotary's emphasis on avoidable blindness increased in 2000, when Devlyn was Rotary International president. He is the president and CEO of Devlyn Optical Group, now the largest optical store chain in Latin America with operations in Mexico, Guatemala and Colombia.

The academy gives Rotary high marks for a club-sponsored program that brings talented ophthalmologists from developing nations to the United States for two-week educational, cultural and social immersion sessions. Participating eye doctors visit the sponsoring rotary clubs' meetings and attend the academy's annual meeting. To date, Rotary clubs have provided this opportunity to 41 ophthalmologists from 27 countries.

The Special Recognition Award is presented to an individual or organization for outstanding service in a specific effort or cause that improves the quality of eye care. It was first awarded in 1991. The AAO president has the honor of selecting the recipient of this award. The recipient is then approved by the AAO Board of Trustees to be recognized at the Annual Meeting.
